Eclipse-City Ltd and the Government of Jiayuguan (China) engage in a cooperation agreement to jointly and exclusively host and manage the "Total Solar Eclipse Event" that will pass by the territory of the Gansu Province on August 1 2008, just one week prior to the Summer Olympic Games to be held in Beijing.

Federico Avellán Borgmeyer (Founder and Managing Director Eclipse-City Ltd.) and Mr. Gerald Xia (Vice Mayor, Jiayuguan Municipal Government, Gansu Province, China) have signed a cooperation agreement to work together very closely over the next 18 months to make this event a complete success.

Eclipse-City Ltd is the world leader in solar eclipse event management, taking "eclipse-chasers", scientists, incentive travelers, students, newly weds, entrepreneurs and professionals of all kind, as well as heads of state and managers from larger organizations from all over the world, to the point of best eclipse experiencing, into regions that can be as remote as the Antarctic Continent, The Libyan Desert, The South Pacific, or now, coming up in 2008, to Siberia's Steppe or China's Silk Road and the Gobi Desert.

The Government of Jiayuguan is home to Jiayuguan Pass, the largest and most intact pass, or entrance, of the Great Wall. Jiayuguan Pass was built in the early Ming dynasty, somewhere around the year 1372. It was built near an oasis that was then on the extreme western edge of China. Jiayuguan Pass was the first pass on the west end of the Great Wall so it earned the name "The First And Greatest Pass Under Heaven".

Some 1.500 - 2.000 international travelers will be there with Eclipse-City experiencing this event, which will be accompanied by some additional 2-3 Million local and 0,5 - 1,5 Billion people, who will join the event via Satellite TV or any other broadcast and communications media organized by Eclipse-City and/or its partners.
